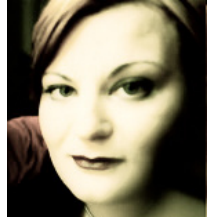
L'Ecole Superieure des Arts Appliques de Duperre - Paris

Step 1

Research time: Define a concept through experimentation, brainstorming and different approaches of fashion.

Step 2

Development time: 3 workshops to develop the concept applying 3 different techniques. In accomplishing the project, each student will focus on all about volume and embellishment techniques such as embroideries and the use of unexpected materials for an extraordinary final exhibition.

All applicants have to complete and send the individual registration form to the Arts of Fashion Foundation as soon as possible as class size is limited to 20 students. After the 20th student registered, all next students will be on a waiting list and be contacted if some spots would be available. Students on the waiting list will be contacted in order of receipt of their registration form.

Tuition Fees

Tuition fees are \$3,800 for the four-week program | Five-day a week | 9AM - 5PM (with one hour lunch break) | 140 hours and correspondent ESAA Duperre credits | All courses will be taught in English by the Duperre fashion faculty and designers.

Visas

Please note that all visitors will need to present a valid passport (that does not expire before the end of the visit), proof of sufficient funds and a return airline ticket.

For US citizen, a visa is not needed. After going through the French custom you will be free to travel in the Schengen space during the period of your stay for less than 3-month stay.
